### 2018-2019 DREDGE OPERATIONS

### OFF-SEASON MAINTENANCE TASKS

In preparation for the 2018-2019 dredge season, crews have been actively working to complete off-season maintenance tasks, which includes restoration of the workboat, *Dauntless*, and fabrication of a snorkel for the dredge, *Twin Lakes*.

Dauntless is undergoing a complete underwater surface restoration, including sandblasting, selective re-plating and reapplying protective coating systems. Twin Lakes' snorkel fabrication is currently underway.

We would like to thank maintenance and dredge crews for their continued hard work during the off-season!

### **DREDGING OPERATIONS**
