2015-2016 DREDGE SEASON UPDATE

Federal Channel (Entrance) Dredging 2015-16 Season The dredge *Seabright* is currently at anchor in the federal entrance channel. The crew will commence entrance dredging the week of November 23.

Entrance dredging will continue through the first week of December, to address the shoal that is beginning to form at the harbor entrance. Disposal of material will be accomplished using a combination of offshore, onshore and surf zone disposal, in accordance with permits and as conditions warrant.

Entrance dredging will temporarily cease the week of December 7, while the crew mobilizes to dredge the north harbor.

North Harbor Dredging - December 2015

Dredging of the north harbor area (X/J channel) will be performed over several days using *Seabright*, which will be mobilized in the north harbor the week of December 7. Dredging is anticipated to occur over several days between approximately December 10-14. Please check the website for schedule updates.


Boaters in the north harbor area should be particularly vigilant about pipeline and equipment hazards in the area.

Pass Seabright on the east side (Crow's Nest side) of the

channel unless otherwise marked. Stay at least 50' from the dredge. Contact the crew for passing instructions on VHF channel 8.

The cross channel pipe is marked with a green buoy at the west end and a red buoy at the east end. Stay between the buoys at all times.
