SANTA CRUZ HARBOR BOATYARD AT YOUR SERVICE

The Santa Cruz Harbor Boatyard is equipped to serve the Santa Cruz boating community. The boatyard can handle large and small sail and power boats with its 50 ton Travelift. We are proud to offer competitive rates and friendly service right here in the Santa Cruz Harbor. Boaters can "Do-It-Yourself" or choose from our list of numerous local boat repair contractors. The boatyard has a small chandlery and can special order parts and supplies with a 24-hour delivery in most cases.

The Port District reopened the boatyard in April 2014. Since then, hundreds of customers have used the yard for haulouts, surveys, repairs, painting, fiberglass work, mast-stepping, bottom cleaning, engine repairs, bright work and general boat maintenance. Customers have come from as far away as the Sacramento/San Joaquin Delta to work on their boats in the clean, friendly Santa Cruz environment.

The boatyard offers special rates seasonally, like rainy day specials and discounts for commercial fishermen. Stop by and meet our helpful crew, see the world-famous Santa Cruz 70 *Merlin*, check out the recently restored historic felucca *Pappy*, and learn more about the Santa Cruz Harbor Boatyard.

TWIN LAKES BEACHFRONT PROJECT

The Twin Lakes Beachfront Improvement Project formally commenced on September 15, 2016 at the Harbor Beach Plaza. This project will improve coastal access along East Cliff Drive from the harbor entrance at 5th Avenue to the intersection of East Cliff Drive and 7th Avenue. Pedestrian paths, bike lanes, parking spaces, and beach stairways and ramps will greatly improve beach access along Twin Lakes Beach. GraniteRock, the contractor for this project, is scheduled to begin on-site construction in early-October. Although the construction schedule is a work in progress and subject to change, the general plan for this project is to:

- Begin work to widen the road on the north side of East Cliff Drive (residential side)
- Construct the retaining wall on the south side of East Cliff Drive (beach side)
- 3. Rebuild the roadway between 5th and 7th Avenue

The project is expected to take approximately nine months to complete. Harbor businesses will remain open and East Cliff Drive will be open to two-way traffic throughout construction. Visitor parking is available in harbor parking areas.

DREDGING UPDATE

North Harbor Dredging

Dredging of the north harbor is scheduled to begin on Monday, October 3, 2016. The crew plans to use the Port District's 8" hydraulic dredge, *Squirt*, to dredge the north harbor. *Squirt's* smaller size is ideal for dredging smaller fairways and slip areas of the inner-harbor. Furthermore, *Squirt* was renovated last year with a new diesel engine that is compliant with State of California's Airborne Toxic Control Measure. This will reduce emissions of diesel particulate matter and eliminate *Squirt's* previous 80-hour per year operating restriction. The crew strives to complete north harbor dredging earlier in the season this year, so they can concentrate on entrance dredging from November to April.

Entrance Dredging

The Port District's new dredge, *Twin Lakes*, will be mobilized to the south harbor in mid-October. The crew plans to begin dredging the entrance beginning in mid-November and continuing through April 2017.
